Kerr is the creator of *WORK WORK WORK WORK WORK WORK WORK* – An experimental platform for text, image and artwork regarding the representation of labour in art, and co-creator of the platform softandhardwares.com – A cross-disciplinary project examining the relationship between the post digital and textiles in contemporary art.
